



Quick Stats on EducationSuperHighway

- EducationSuperHighway helped catalyze President Obama's **ConnectED** initiative in 2013.
- EducationSuperHighway raised **\$1 MILLION** in seed round of funding and **\$9.2 MILLION** in series A funding from investors including The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and the Chan Zuckerberg Initiative. The organization since secured an additional **\$20 MILLION** from the Chan Zuckerberg Initiative.
- In 2014, EducationSuperHighway helped increase the size of the federal E-rate program by **1.5 BILLION** per year (to a total of **\$3.9 BILLION**).
- Founder and CEO Evan Marwell was named **2015 Visionary of the Year** by the *San Francisco Chronicle*.
- Conducted an in-depth analysis of public E-rate data and released the annual **State of the States report** on the status of broadband connectivity in America's K-12 public schools.
- Secured commitments from **42 U.S. governors** to prioritize broadband connectivity for schools in their states.

Quick Stats on Status of Connectivity in U.S. Classrooms

11.6 MILLION STUDENTS

continue to be left behind despite the tremendous progress of connecting 30 million more students since 2013.

3,700 SCHOOLS

need a fiber connection in order to scale to meet future bandwidth demand.

15 SERVICE PROVIDERS

could upgrade 6 million students if they upgraded 100 percent of the school districts they serve to 100 kbps per student.

15,000 SCHOOLS

need sufficient Wi-Fi to support 1:1 learning environments.
